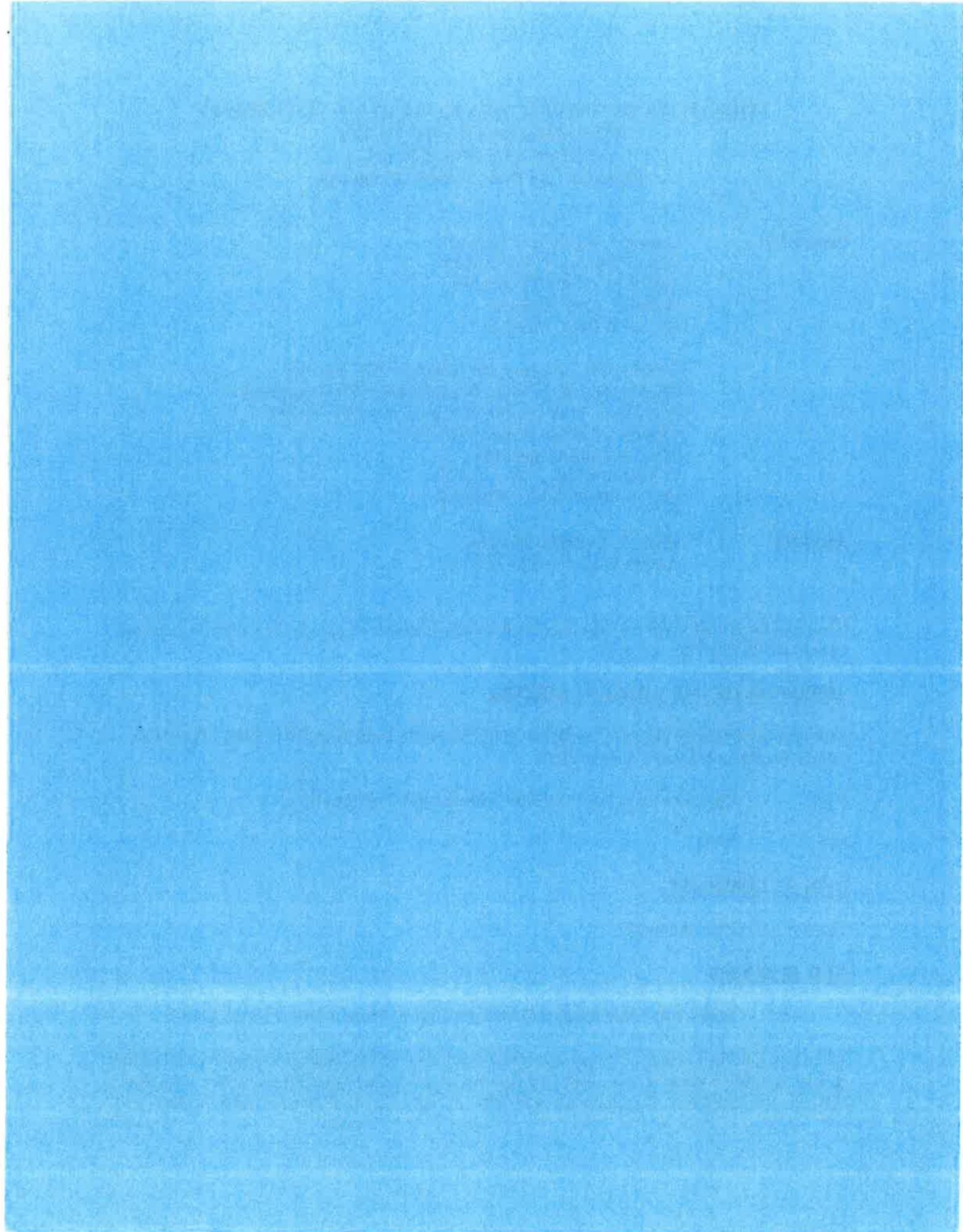

Chairman Booth called the meeting to order at approximately 8:30 a.m. in the Council Chambers located at 500 City Hall Avenue.

APPROVAL OF THE CONSENT AGENDA

Vice Chairman Meetze moved, seconded by Director Apelt, to approve the Consent Agenda as submitted. Recorded vote on the motion:

YES: Directors Trant, Apelt, Webber, Meetze and Chairman Booth.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

NEW BUSINESS

1. *Revise BMP Maintenance Contract to Reflect Fiscal Year – Theresa Owens*

Theresa S. Owens, Financer Director, requested that the Directors consider the amendment of the current contract entitled, *Storm Water Retention Pond Easement and Maintenance Agreement* between the Economic Development Authority of the City of Poquoson and Fountains of

Poquoson, LLC, dated May 6, 2014 to reflect collection of the maintenance funds on a fiscal year as opposed to a calendar year as stated in Article 4, Sub-paragraph 4.2. Ms. Owens explained that since the City's budget is on a fiscal calendar (July 1st to June 30th) it makes financial recordkeeping difficult when collecting fees scheduled for a calendar year (January 1st to December 31st).

Director Trant moved, seconded by Vice Chairman Meetze, to approve the amendment to the May 6, 2014 contract from a calendar year to a fiscal year and to request Attorney Wayne Moore to amend the contract accordingly. Recorded vote on the motion:

YES: Directors Trant, Apelt, Webber, Meetze and Chairman Booth.

NO: None.

2. *EDA Big Woods Study Group*

Chairman Booth advised the Directors that Poquoson Councilman Carey Freeman, Poquoson City Council, and Poquoson Planning Commissioner Gustavus A. Goddin, will be serving on the Council requested Working Committee which will analyze and make a recommendation regarding which of the preferred development concepts for the EDA 6-acre assemblage is most desirable for further study. It was determined that staff would contact all of the members on the committee, including Rick Weddle, HREDA Executive Director, who had agreed to facilitate this meeting to arrange the first meeting as early as possible in October.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. *Alphus Street BMP Overview – Ellen Roberts*

Ellen W. Roberts, Engineer, was asked to provide the EDA with possible enhancements to its BMP to bring it in-line with existing ponds in the City. Ms. Roberts stated that plants such as holly would be an environmentally responsible choice. She explained that several plants and bushes could be planted around the pond in addition to the existing vegetation in order to reduce associated costs. In conclusion, she stated that it was possible to stretch the plantings over a few years.

2. *Review of EDA Properties*

Director Trant handed each member of the EDA a packet which included a summary of the 20 properties currently owed by the EDA with a brief history and recommendation for each. He expressed thanks to Attorney Moore for providing the history of each property since many of the Directors were not members of the EDA when they were acquired. Director Trant asked the Directors to review each property and be prepared to discuss the disposition of each at the next meeting.

3. *Comprehensive Plan Update*

Director Trant reported that he had been unable to attend every meeting of the CPT; however, Mr. Dannan R. O'Connell, Graduate Management Assistant, had been in attendance and agreed to update the EDA. Mr. O'Connell stated that the CPT is conducting regular meetings and is focused on gathering information from the public and local businesses as well. Although there was no reportable information at that time, he stated that the CPT is reviewing the postcards deposited in the special information boxes located at various sites in the City and will be tabulating that information for a future report.

STAFF ACTIVITIES

1. David Callis, Economic Development Director, advised the Directors of the expiration date of the Wetland Delineation for each EDA parcel. The next expiration is Tax Parcel 27-1-94 A (aka Gladys Moore Property) on October 28, 2018.

2. Charity Gavaza, Economic Development Coordinator, stated that she had met with the International Trade Manager/Eastern Virginia, VEDP, regarding import/export support from the Commonwealth of Virginia. She discovered that two Poquoson businesses were currently engaged in international trade, not with manufacturing but in digital products such as software. Ms. Gavaza is sharing this information as there are grant opportunities available for this type of endeavor through VEDP and support, training and networking assistance.

3. The ED Coordinator reported that Corner Bristro & Catering and Tag Time Escape Room expects to hold their ribbon cuttings this month.

The ED Director reminded everyone that the annual Poquoson Seafood Festival would be held October 14 - 16.

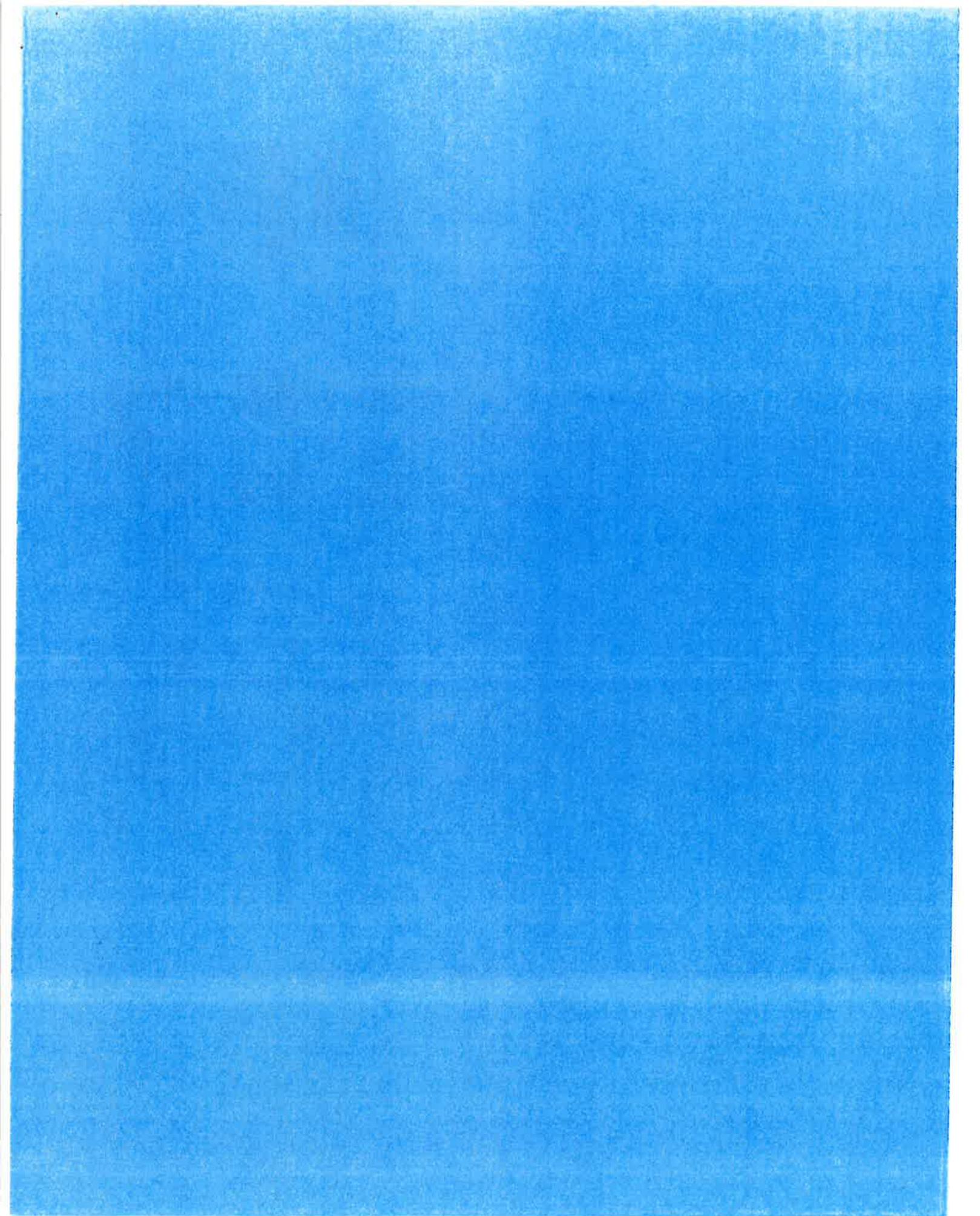
4. The next meeting will be held on the regularly scheduled first Tuesday of the month, November 1st at 8:30 a.m.
